

**RESOLUTION BY THE MADISON ATHENS-CLARKE OCONEE
REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION STUDY (MACORTS)
POLICY COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, amendments to the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) must be approved by the MACORTS Policy Committee and,

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation's State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) and the MACORTS TIP must match, the following items have been amended in the FY 2015 – 2018 Transportation Improvement Program following the transportation planning process:

Section 5339 Capital Funding was increased from a total of \$450,000 (\$360,000 federal; \$90,000 local) to \$2,500,000 (\$2,000,000 federal; \$500,000 local) in the following activity line items:

119-00: Bus Transit Enhancements		
11.91.02	Engineering/Design of Bus Shelters	\$400,000
11.92.02	Acquisition of Bus Shelters	\$750,000
11.93.02	Bus Shelter Construction	\$750,000
11.92.06	Acquisition of Bike Racks	\$125,000
